### AFI Sunday Evening Lectures

**Sunday 7th February  
Ken Ring**

Ken Ring is a former mathematics teacher who began his business Predict Weather Limited in 2002 to supply farmers with something more meaningful than a day-before forecasting system. He is New Zealand's only published long range forecaster and presents at conferences throughout Australasia. Ken is the author of more than 40 books, including 20 on weather and climate. These publications (now in their 14th year) have a strong following amongst the many whose business or leisure activities are affected by the weather.

With weekly spots on Geoff Thomas's fishing show and monthly weather spots on a number of regional radio stations, Ken is a regular on TV and radio in NZ. He has columns in farming magazines and also regional newspapers. For three years Australia's TV network Channel Seven has contracted Ken as their long-range weather consultant. On their Sunrise and Today-Tonight Shows he has monthly presence in all States, and ABC regional radio stations regularly request interviews. Irish media also show huge interest, because of his almanacs for that country and his association with Irish farmers.

His methods are astrological, mainly Moon, Sun and inner planets. 50% of forecasting is related to Moon in the 4<sup>th</sup> House, with lesser influence from Asc and MH positions. Then there are close aspects that use Moon and Sun as triggers. Ken will share some of his methodology, also some of his thoughts on climate change. You will not look at Her Loveliness the Moon in such a forgiving way again...

We all experience momentous events which serve to shape our lives; some are memorable for the happy occasions they were while others memorable for all the wrong reasons. Often the question is asked, what were the planets doing at that time? What in my chart - if anything - triggered the event? Can astrology help to make sense of these life changing events? Conversely, can our life events help us make sense of astrology! Over the next months, this is what we will be exploring - and seeking answers to these and the many other questions that arise - through understanding how our natal charts respond to the transiting planets and planetary cycles.

Working with an ephemeris in pairs or groups we will be studying the astrological dynamics of particular life events experienced by each student. Homework will be set in preparation for the following month's workshop. Each student will have the opportunity to elect an event for everyone to study.

These workshops provide an exciting opportunity to really get to grips with planetary transits - not through reading 'cook-book' renditions of the meanings of the planets, but through actual hands on working with our charts, asking questions of each other and sharing our life stories. The same transits are there for everyone but not everyone responds to or experiences these transits the same way.
