AFI Sunday Evening Lecture

I'll be looking at March in detail, going through the cosmic movements during what is a crossover month and the impact this will be having on your solar chart. I'll cover the main events i.e. the shift in the lunar nodes and their relationship to next year's Venus transit, Uranus' return to Aries, the Saturn/Jupiter opposition and Neptune's pending departure from Aquarius in early April but also where all the planets are in March and what they're up to. Time permitting I'll also talk about the solar chart and how it's used for Horoscope casting.

I have been writing Horoscopes since 1997 but formed my own company Forecasters, www.forecasters.co.nz in December 2002. I am a Horoscope Content provider and provide Horoscope Content to my own website and an 11,000 daily database but also to Newspapers throughout New Zealand, many of the leading websites in New Zealand and into 7 countries internationally (Australia, USA, Canada, South Africa, UK, France and Switzerland). Solar Astrology is based on how the prevailing cosmic conditions are impacting your Sun on a daily basis and the very strong influence this has. I have my first book coming out in December, a 2012 Horoscope Guide aimed at the Kiwi audience and also talking about the Southern Hemisphere Signs versus the North Hemisphere Signs. I often consider myself less an Astrologer and more an Astrological journalist.

Class One March 17: Family as the Threads of Destiny
